Community Mobilizer

Background Information

Youth Changers Kenya (YCK) is a community-based organization that was founded in 2015 to promote sexual reproductive health and rights and to address systemic issues of sexual violence among adolescent girls and young women from rural and peri-urban areas. YCK's work with girls & young women strives to provide knowledge and skills necessary to pursue education, participate in policy spaces, delay pregnancy, make informed choices and build self-confidence.

At the same time, YCK strategically engages with key gatekeepers to build a strong collaboration aimed at developing a more equitable justice system for sexual violence against girls and women. YCK has five thematic areas of focus which include: advocacy, sexual reproductive health and rights, girls' education, mental wellness, and sexual violence. While maintaining a national focus, YCK's focus was honed to in Kiambu, Kakamega, and Nairobi counties owing to the increased rates of SRHR violations in both areas.

We are seeking to recruit a **community mobilizer** based in Kakamega. The community mobilizer will oversee the execution of a project for 18 months aimed at supporting survivors of sexual and gender-based violence. The project seeks to support survivors of sexual and gender-based violence in Kakamega County.

The mobilizer will;

- Identify, verify, and recruit beneficiaries of the project.
- Collate verification documents from the beneficiaries.
- Develop a verification tool.
- Provide a detailed budget of expenses.
- Prepare a logistics note for the group sessions.
- Be the link person for YCK and survivors.
- Booking venue for group counseling sessions.
- Provide invoices, quotations, and credible receipts for all transactions.
- Reconcile all accounts within 72 hours.
- Support the YCK team with other duties when called upon.



Who we are looking for:

- An individual with a strong passion for sexual and reproductive health rights, SGBV, and human rights.
- A strategic and analytical thinker, who is able to quickly come up with effective and tactful solutions.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Someone who is open-minded and curious on matters of reproductive health & SGBV.
- Educational qualification in project management is an added advantage.
- Someone who has a proven record of working independently.
- Diploma in social work, community development, or gender studies.
- An individual with 4 years experience in SRHR, SGBV, or human rights work.

Other information

The role is based in Kakamega. Due to the nature of the work, additional hours may be required. We are looking for candidates who are excited about working in our organization for a minimum of 18 months.
